## FAQ >>> FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

**How do the weekly sports themes work?** Each week we will have a sports theme for the first 3 hours of the program. Campers will then be exposed to a variety of sports and activities the rest of the day.

**Is the cost of camp tax deductible?** Yes. Our Employer Identification Number is 54-2174927. Customers need to have a dependent care flex account set up through their employer. Customers who take advantage of this opportunity can enjoy tax savings in addition to our special discounts.

**Why should I send my child to All Sports Camp?** 1) Your child will have fun 2) Your child will be physically active 3) Your child will read every day 4) Your child will be with an adult teacher in a safe environment 5) Your child will be exposed to over 20 sports 6) Your child will go on field trips once per week.

**When will the campers go on Field Trips?** Thursdays.

**Will the campers at Akron General be outside?** Yes. Campers at Akron General will be outside for approximately 3 hours per day. Campers will participate outdoors in kickball, four square, dodge ball, corn hole, baseball, basketball and football at the Akron General facility.

**Is there a registration fee?** The registration fee is \$30 per camper with a \$60 family maximum fee.

**Is there any cost to the before and after camp care?** The before and after camp care is free of cost. Campers can come as early as 7am and stay as late as 6pm. The daily program begins at 9am and ends at 3pm.

**How do you group the campers?** We group the campers based on age with an emphasis of friends together. Activities are age-appropriate.

**My child likes sports but is not an All Star. Will my child have fun?** Yes, because our camp staff strives to treat every camper like an All Star. Individual improvement and fun are stressed above competing against other campers.

**What are the arrangements for lunch and snacks?** The campers will have snack time everyday at 10:30am. Lunch will be at 12pm each day. Campers are to bring their own snacks, water bottle, and lunch.

**What is the schedule on rainy days?** Akron General has access to indoor facilities.

**How does the early bird discount work?** Campers who are registered by March 20 will receive up to a \$5 discount per week.

**Does my child need to bring any equipment?** Campers are welcome to bring their own baseball bat and glove. We will provide bats and gloves for those campers who choose not to bring their own. All other equipment will be provided by the All Sports Camp.

**How is payment accepted online?** All payments are made online

**Is there an emphasis on any sport during the different camp weeks?** Our philosophy is to expose campers to all sports early in the week, then give campers choices towards the end of the week.
