

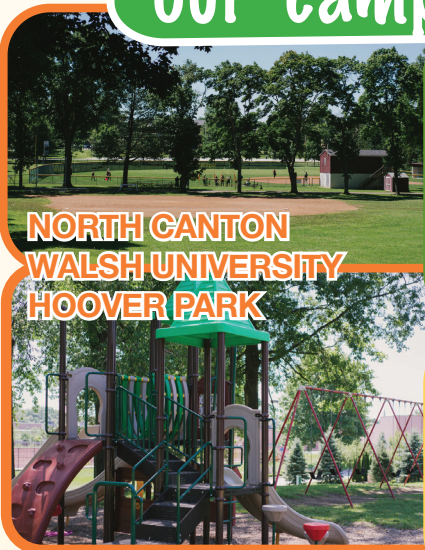

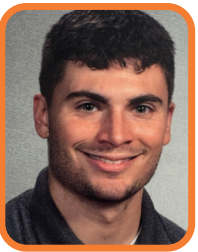
KEVIN FINEFROCK
